RACE LEADERS:

RECORD FOR RACE LEADERS AT TORONTO (6), IOWA SPEEDWAY (10), MID-OHIO SPORTS CAR COURSE (7) AND POCONO RACEWAY (12). 2015 ALSO SAW THE MOST LEADERS AT TEXAS (9) SINCE JUNE 2002.
